ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

The minimum qualifications for entry to the College are:

- A. four (4) passes at CSEC General Proficiency Level with Grades 1, 2 and 3 as of June 1998.**
- B. four (4) passes at GCE Ordinary Level with Grade A, B, or C.**
- C. any qualifications considered by the College to be equivalent.**

N.B. English Language Must be included in the four passes.

The minimum qualifications for entry to the Bachelor Degree programmes are:

Five (5) passes at CSEC General Proficiency Level with Grades 1, 2 and 3 as of June 1998.

NB. All Applicants to the BSc programmes in the Division of Health Sciences are required to possess passes in Biology, Human & Social Biology, Integrated Science or Mathematics.

Please check the College’s website, www.bcc.edu.bb for specific prerequisites to particular programmes.

Persons whose native language is not English, should have a TOEFL score of 550.

Persons 25 years or older who do not possess the minimum qualifications may be admitted as Mature Students. This is subject to approval by the respective Division.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

ALL APPLICANTS are required to submit the following documents:

- 1. Barbados Identification Card AND Birth Certificate OR**

- 3. Where applicable, documented evidence of a change in name must be submitted (E.g. Marriage Certificate, Deed Poll, Affidavit)**
- 4. Persons not born in Barbados should provide evidence of their status (if any) in Barbados (E.g. Permanent Resident, Immigrant).**
- 5. Academic Qualifications. (CSEC, GCE or other examination results)**
- 6. Transcripts from Colleges & Universities should be sent directly to the College from the institution in signed, sealed envelopes.**
