

**THE BARBADOS POLICE COOPERATIVE CREDIT UNION LTD CARTER AND HUSTSON  
MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP: BCC**

**REGULATIONS**

**1. NAME OF AWARD**

- 1.1 The Award shall be called **The Barbados police Co-operative Credit Union Ltd Carter and Hutson Memorial Scholarship** and shall be tenable at the Barbados Community College.

**2. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

- 2.1 The Award shall be open to members of the Barbados Police Co-operative Credit Union or the children or wards of the members in good standing.
- 2.2 Applicants must have successfully completed the year of any programme of two years or more duration prior to the year for which they are applying for the award of the scholarship.
- 2.3 The Scholarship shall be awarded on the basis of the applicant's academic performance of a GPA of 3.0 or above in the year prior to the year for which he or she is applying for the award of the scholarship.
- 2.4 Awardees must adhere to all aspects of BCC code of conduct.
- 2.5 Financial need will only be taken into account as a tie-breaker.

**3. DURATION AND VALUE OF AWARD**

- 3.1. The Award shall be for the duration of one (1) academic year.
- 3.2. The valued of the award shall be **BDS \$1,500.00** to be used in meeting the awardee's cost of fees, study materials, preparation of papers, projects and incidental expenses.

**4. ADVERTISEMENT AND SELECTION**

- 4.1 The availability of the Award shall be suitably advertised by the Barbados community College and the Barbados Police Co-operative Credit Union Limited.
- 4.2 The Barbados Community College shall provide the Barbados Police Co-operative Credit Union Limited with a short list of applicants for the award. The shortlist must be accompanied by the completed application forms and appropriate documentary evidence of each applicant's academic performance.
- 4.3 The Barbados Police Co-operative Credit Union Limited and he Scholarship Trustees shall make the final selection of the awardee.

**5. FINACIAL PROCEDURE**

- 5.1 The Barbados Police Co-operative Union Limited shall pay each academic year pay to the Barbados Community College no later than 1<sup>st</sup> September, the sum of BDS \$1,500.00 in pursuance of Regulation 3 above with respect to each scholarship.
- 5.2 After the deduction of relevant fees and charges payable by the award holder to the Barbados Community College, the latter will disburse the annual amount to the awardee in two (2) allotments, one at the start of each of the two semesters of the academic year for which the scholarship is tenable.
