ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

The minimum qualifications for entry to the Associate Degree are:

- A. **Four (4)** passes at CSEC General Proficiency Level with Grades 1, 2 and 3 as of June 1998.
- B. **Four (4)** passes at GCE Ordinary Level with Grades A, B or C.
- C. **Any** qualifications considered by the college to be equivalent.

N.B. English Language is compulsory.

The minimum qualifications for entry to the Bachelor Degree programmes are:

Five (5) passes at CSEC General Proficiency Level with Grades 1, 2 and 3 as of June 1998.

Persons whose native language is not English, should have a TOEFL score of 550.

Persons 25 years or older who do not possess the minimum qualifications may be admitted as Mature Students. This is subject to approval of the respective Division.

Applicants to **Clinical Laboratory Science and Psychology** must be at least 17 years old while those applying for **General Nursing** must be at least 16 years old. Applicants applying to **Pharmacy** must be at least 18 years old..

Social Work – Applicants must submit with their applications, a personal statement of not more than 600 words along with two written recommendations attesting to their suitability for the social work profession. Applicants must be at least 17 years old.

Diploma in Education (Technical & Applied) – Applicants must indicate their area of specialty (teaching) when applying.

Dance/Theatre Arts/Music – All applicants will be required to attend an audition.

Certificate in Fashion – All Applicants **MUST** submit 10 Fashion sketches and 3 garments when they attend the interview.

Mass Communication & Media & Journalism – All Applicants must submit a 300-word essay outlining their interest in the field.

Visual Arts – Persons applying for admission to this programme are required to complete a Portfolio consisting of the following projects:

- Using materials of your choice, visually interpret, in colour, one of the most interesting and memorable events of your life and then explain it in not less than one hundred (100) words on the reverse side of the paper.
- Use cut/torn paper to construct a collage representing a still life composition OR a landscape.
- Make a free-hand drawing of a part of a room, which includes at least three pieces of furniture or three objects. Draw this view as realistically as possible, placing emphasis on shading and proportion.
- Arrange two chairs in an interesting way, and then make a drawing of these chairs as accurately as you can. This drawing is to be done free-hand – you **must not** use a ruler to help you do the drawing.
- Select three objects and place them on a window-sill/ledge, or a table in front of a window where you can see both the objects and the view behind the objects.
- Make a drawing of your hand holding an object that has a special meaning to you.

Each assignment must be completed on a separate sheet of 11 x 17 paper. Additional work should not be submitted.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR APPLICANTS

Applicants to **Clinical Laboratory Science** and the **Nursing Auxiliary** programmes must be at least 17 years old while those applying for **General Nursing** must be at least 16 years old. Applicants applying to **Pharmacy** and **Psychology** must be at least 17 years old.

Requirements for the Portfolio for Visual Arts

Visual Arts – Persons applying for admission to this programme are required to complete a portfolio consisting of the following projects:

- Using materials of your choice, visually interpret, in colour, one of the most interesting and memorable events of your life and then explain it in not less than one hundred (100) words on the reverse side of the paper.
- Use cut/torn paper to construct a collage representing a still life composition OR a landscape.
- Make a free-hand drawing of a part of a room, which includes at least three pieces of furniture or three objects. Draw this view as realistically as possible, placing emphasis on shading and proportion.
- Arrange two chairs in an interesting way, and then make a drawing of these chairs as accurately as you can. This drawing is to be done free-hand – you **must not** use a ruler to help you do the drawing.
- Select three objects and place them on a window-sill/ledge, or a table in front of a window where you can see both the objects and the view behind the objects.
- Make a drawing of your hand holding an object that has a special meaning to you.

Each assignment must be completed on a separate sheet of 11 x 17 paper. Additional work should not be submitted.

Architectural Studies – Persons applying for admission to this programme are required to submit a portfolio on July 17th 2026. The portfolio should consist of the following:

Home Exercise – Photo Documented Submission

Take one (10 tabloid size sheet of paper or thin card stock (11” x 17”) and transform it to make a three-dimensional sculpture.

Please follow these rules in the making of your project:

1. You are to use only one sheet of paper - excluding a base that you may attach it to if you wish.
2. You are restricted to making two cuts in that piece of paper.
3. You are restricted to taping, gluing or stapling the paper in only for locations.

Things to consider:

- The composition of the sculpture should be interesting from different angles.
- Demonstrate that you took care in the creation of this construction (be neat).
- We are looking for a demonstration of aptitude and creativity.

Graphic Submission (Original works ONLY)

1. A drawing of a cluster of objects in an arranged composition: a chair or chairs, a collection of organic material (e.g. leaves, bark) and, a drawing of a bag or group of bags.
2. Draw an **interior perspective** of your favourite room in the home.
3. Sketch an **exterior perspective** of a local building, which you consider to be architecturally appealing.
4. Use your imagination and sketch something in **motion/moving** through time.
5. Five (5) examples of artistic and design work where your skills and passion are expressed most strongly.

Your examples could be from any of the following areas:

- Free-hand sketches, painting
- Photography, Models (Sculptures) / 3D Work (Woodwork)
- Paintings, Collages/Montages
- Sketch Studies, Graphic Design, Printmaking
- Orthographic drawings
- Precedent Studies/Research Projects (artists/architects)

All submissions must be no larger than 11” x 17” size paper and bonded in a book form.

Place a carefully crafted caption for each slide indicating the intent, elaborate on the process and method, and reflect on the outcome. Include a note that lists the size and medium of each piece, as well as, whether the work was completed in class or independently. If a group collaborated on any of the samples included in the portfolio, please clearly indicate what you were instrumental in contributing.

The Architectural Studies selection committee strongly discourages the inclusion of technical/mechanical construction documents in the portfolio. It is very important that the portfolio contains work illustrating your creativity rather than only your technical ability. Requirements for the Portfolio for Game Art & Animation Programmes

- **Diploma in Game Art & Animation**
- **Associate Degree in Applied Arts – Game Art & Animation**
- **Bachelor of Arts - Game Art & Animation**

Persons applying for admission to any of the Game Art & Animation Programmes are required to submit:

1. **Personal Statement** – In no less than 1000 words, answer the question “Why am I pursuing a programme in Game Art and Animation?”
2. **Portfolio** - At least three (3) pieces of original work

Details on how to submit these documents will be provided at a later date.

Requirements for the Portfolios for Bachelor of Fine Arts (Studio Art)

- Photographs of 8-10 pieces of applicant’s best artwork, representing a variety of mediums and skills. At least two (2) of the pieces must be representational drawings from observation (not drawn from a photo).
- 3-5 images of pages from the applicant’s sketchbook or of any sketches that help illustrate the applicant’s creative process.
